If you playthrough it once you can always create another character and do things differently. I have two characters in which I take different options. Not all options will change the outcome of things though I should warn you, there is some illusion of choice, but nevertheless it does allow you to really be your character and the characters I play really feel like my own.

The writing is good and its easy to get immersed into things, and I definitely feel attached to the characters. After being with them in the story and interacting with them throughout the story you genuinely care about them.

You can choose certain aspects of your Ronin character, such as their name and aspects of their personality, but there are many things you also cannot personalise which makes sense. Just a warning.

Be warned about the cliffhanger at the end.

I recommend playing the first game before this one.. Where is the third book god dammit! I need more!. I consider Book 1 a masterpiece. Along with "Champion of Gods", it was my favorite "Choice of Games" adventure.

This, however, I simply despise. It feels like a different person wrote Book 2. It is dull, much of the story is forced upon you and it's nowhere near as intuitive as the first one was. It's far more mechanical, whereas 1 allowed you to just play and never look back at your stats, as long as you sticked to playing the character you wanted.

I have yet to play part 3 of this series, but I'm already worried it will not live up to the fantastic start that book 1 was.
